Welcome to the February edition of The Bridge.

On the 14th February we mark Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent -46 days before Easter. The Parish church will mark this event during our 10am Holy Communion Service and all are welcome. Interestingly this is the same day as Valentine's day, which is the first time this has happened since 1945.

Easter will fall this year on 1st April – April Fool's Day. Many today might suggest that this is fitting because it is foolish to believe that a man can be killed by crucifixion on the Friday, left in a tomb until the Sunday and then get up without showing any ill effects. And to be fair they have a point, it is impossible. But what is impossible for man is possible for God and so I am convinced that Jesus did indeed rise again to life. In his letter to the Corinthians, found in the bible, the Apostle Paul acknowledges that some people will think it foolishness to believe in the resurrection. He writes, 'For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but it is God's power to us who are being saved'. 1 Corinthians 1: 18

At the end of January I took the funeral of Blanche Walker who celebrated her 100th birthday last year. Blanche was, over many years, active in our community and in the church. I am pleased to have known Blanche and to know that for her the cross was not foolishness but God's power to save. I would encourage all who read this to reflect on the cross.



WATER ORTON MEMORIAL GROUP

The memorial project consultation took place on 6th January. The survey on Facebook and papers completed on the day produced in total 71 results and showed 84.5% in favour of having names on the memorial and 60% against names of soldiers from other local areas being included on the memorial. Please be assured that these results and all comments will be taken forward in the design process. We have raised £13,000 of £25,500 needed to date but are hoping to get the remaining funds underwritten whilst we continue fundraising, to allow us to order the Memorial stone by March. We are planning to have it in place for dedication in October, enabling us to hold the Remembrance Service at the Memorial on 11.11.2018.

Our first fundraising event this year is a Quiz on 9th February. This will be held at Water Orton Cricket Club at 7.30pm. Teams of maximum 6 people, and tickets £5 each person.
